




2 With the menu option open, select HTML5 Tracker.




3 The HTML5 Tracker identifies unsupported flash objects on various pages in the lesson.


Page transitions and rollover actions generally do not work with HTML5 and need to be removed.




4 In this example, page 2 has a Fade transition applied. Remove the transition.



5 The HTML5 Tracker updates and shows the Flash item has been removed.



6 Rollover actions also need to be removed and replaced with Advanced Actions that show or hide groups.



7 Once the Flash item is removed, the HTML5 Tracker refreshes. When nothing is left, then the Flash has been removed from the lesson. It can be saved, exported and re-uploaded into the LMS.
